Spencer Memorial Gymnasium 1926-1951 (Years 24, Won 135, Lost 79, Pct. Then use of the Winchester High School gym was obtained for basketball. It was necessary for the students to go clear across town on game nights to see the Panthers uphold the glory of their Alma Mater. Five hundred people would crowd the place, and when a good game was on all who wanted to could not get in.

As the teams got better, the demand for a better and bigger place grew. Then things began to happen. Interest was aroused, enthusiasm was stirred up, and the next thing the money was raised and Spencer Memorial Gymnasium was built.

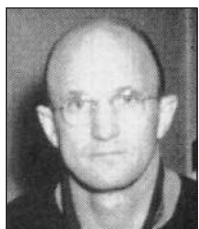

The Owensboro Sportscenter, home of the Kentucky Wesleyan Panthers, is the largest arena in the Great Lakes Valley Conference and the 15th largest in the nation (NCAA Division II), with a seating capacity of 5,002.

Kentucky Wesleyan opened its playing career in the Sportscenter on February 26, 1951 before a full house against Centre College. The Panthers won 114-71.

Seventeen NCAA regional championships have been staged at the Owensboro Sportscenter.

The largest crowd ever to see a Kentucky Wesleyan game at the Sportscenter was 7,500 (standing room only) against Louisville on January 8, 1964, and Evansville on January 13, 1965.
